

TREASURES IN HEAVEN

ST PATRICKS DAY CRAFT

Supplies:

1 Paper plate

Scissors

rainbow colored yarns - 12 inches of each color

yellow construction paper

black marker

hole puncher

Instructions:

- Cut a paper plate in half.
- Draw a cloud shape with one half and a pot with the other half.
- Cut these shapes out & color the pot black.
- Hole punch the top of the pot & bottom of the cloud with 6 holes, one for each color of the rainbow.
- Take a piece of yellow construction paper and fold it in half 3 times. Trace a circle onto the paper & cut it out (keeping the paper folded).
- While keeping the circles together, punch a hole at the top and the bottom of the yellow circle.
- Use a marker to write the Bible verse on the yellow circles. "But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven" you can even add Matthew 6:20 to the cloud.
- Measure out 12 inches of each color yarn. It is important that all strands are the same length to assure they will be even once knotted.
- Turn the cloud and pot over to the back. Starting with the first hole on the right, thread the red yarn into the pot from the top to the bottom. Then thread the yarn into a yellow circle "But", making a note to not cover the words. Then thread it back through the cloud- this time going from the bottom up.
- Put the loose ends together and tie into a knot.
- Repeat this process with all of the other colored yarns and yellow circles.
- Arrange the knots so they are out of sight or tape them to the back. A bit of tape can also be used to make the yellow circles stay put or let them move around the yarns.
- The 'Treasures in Heaven' craft is complete.
